We understand and respect that no one really loves fundraising but through your generous support last year, we were able to raise about \$88,000 which netted us nearly \$49,300 to fund programs to support approximately 1800 students in the Millbury Public Schools. Our net fundraising target for this school year is to raise \$40,000 to fund programs throughout grades PreK-12. We aim to adhere to the following budgetary guidelines when considering funding requests:

- 45% towards off-site field trips
- 25% towards on-site enrichment programs
- 10% towards community events & scholarships
- 10% towards school & classroom tools
- 10% towards health and well-being programs

We do hope that we can count on your continued support again this year since we can't do this without you. We look forward to another fantastic school year!
